



Artwork Requirement for Signs

Please read and follow the Artwork Requirements for Signs guideline when supplying your own artwork for signs.

File Types

Our preferred format for signs is PDF, other formats also acceptable include Vector EPS, Adobe Illustrator AI files, Photoshop, TIFF or JPEG depending by the sign process to be taken. Please ensure images are supplied at a minimum of 300dpi for quality output.

3D Lettering & Vinyl Cut Decals – Vector file is required for this process, ensure all fonts and shapes are outlined.

Banners – Graphic design for banners can be either vector or raster files is printing is required, ensure a minimum of 300dpi for images at 100%.

File Types may vary depending by the sign process to be used, if you are unsure about the file requirements for your signs, contact us and we'll advise you to the correct file requirements.

Colours

Please note PMS or CMYK colours on your designs, we will endeavor to match your colours correctly however not all printing process can match this exactly. We will advise this accordingly.

Please note:

- Percentage of PMS colours should be avoided
- Every colour output mechanism produces a different range of colours and the original image that appears on your print devices, please be aware that material will each render the colour differently from our output devices or materials

Sending Artwork

Please send your artwork to signs@trixle.com.au if it is under 5mb in size. For files larger than 5 mb, please supply artwork on a CD and send it to 1 Smidmore St, Marrickville NSW 2204.

Fonts

Please make sure all fonts in artwork are converted to outlines or curves to ensure the correct designs are created.

All artwork needs to be approved and signed prior to creating your signs
